

GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

UNIVERSAL EMERGENCY NUMBER

112

In case of fire

- ❑ Rescue those in immediate danger, warn others at risk
- ❑ Dial **112** from a safe place to make an emergency call
- ❑ Start to extinguish the fire, but only if you feel safe
- ❑ Close the doors and windows and turn off the ventilation to prevent the fire from spreading
- ❑ Do not enter the stairway if you see smoke
- ❑ Guide the rescue unit to the scene
 - The order of these steps may vary
 - **SMOKE CAN BE DEADLY !**

GENERAL ALARM SIGNAL



- ❑ Go indoors and stay there
- ❑ Close all doors, windows and vents and turn off the ventilation
- ❑ Turn on the radio and calmly wait for instructions
- ❑ Avoid making any unnecessary calls
- ❑ For your own safety, do not leave the area without an order from authorities!
